

Dear Greenmount Ward Family,

We are pleased to announce as of this Sunday the 20th Sept. we have been given approval by Elder Stevenson to return to full membership sacrament meetings (no split congregation). The second hour of the church has not been authorized at this stage.

This is a great blessing, to all come and unite together, and will require each of us to do our part to comply with both Government and Church Covid-19 policies which remain in place. As a reminder, a list of the policy requirements is listed below, which will require seating back to and potentially on the stage.

Hygiene

- If any member is feeling sick or unwell should remain at home.
- Hand sanitizer is available in the main entry or foyer.
- Hymnbooks, programs, and handouts are not to be used or distributed.
- Pulpit and touchable surfaces cleaned after each speaker.

Social Distancing

- Household family members can sit together. We must continue to ensure that there is adequate social distancing between members not of the same household.
- The standard continues to be 1.5 meters.
- Allow 2 square meters per person.
- Members should be seated in alternating rows to facilitate the passing of the sacrament.
- All must refrain from shaking hands, embracing, and congregating together socially.

Administering the Sacrament

- The manner in which we have been administering the sacrament at church will remain in place.
- Sacrament will no longer be authorized to be administered at home. Anyone who wishes to have sacrament at home will require the Bishop's approval.

Additional Use of Chapel

The chapel building can now be used for other purposes as long as the social distancing and hygiene policies are followed. This includes the reopening of the family history center.

Please contact a member of the bishopric to discuss your social distancing and hygiene plan before the building can be used.
